This programme is intended to provide graduates with competence in the field of occupational medicine, skills necessary to render effective, ethical and quality occupational health services in the private, public and academic sectors. The Program also includes a core component of research which enables the applicant to get broader knowledge and depth of occupational epidemiology and public health.

Duration

The Supernumerary Registrar Post is offered for a four (4) year contract period within the University which includes the Research Component, Masters of Medicine (Occ Med).

Essential Information:

This is a **self-funded** post with NO funding from the Discipline or the University. Applicants will be solely responsible for the funding of this post. The Applicant will graduate with a Masters in Medicine (Occ Med) from the University of KwaZulu-Natal and the Fellowship of Public Health Medicine (Occupational Medicine) from the Colleges of Medicine South Africa; once he/she has met all requirements during the training program. Applicants must be registered at the University for the mandatory modules within the Masters program

Applicants should have the minimum requirements of:

- MBChB degree or equivalent, and be at least two years post community service
- Current registration with the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA)
- Completed Postgraduate Diploma of Occupational Health at an accredited University
- 2-5 years' experience working in the field of Occupational Medicine
- A motivation letter to elaborate the reason/s for applying for the Post
- An updated Curriculum Vitae (CV)
